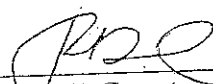

The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant on Monday April 21ST 2014, at approximately 02:17, at 635 W. TENNESSEE ST did the following violation of law:

FACTS TO SUPPORT ABOVE CHARGE(S): On 4/21/14 at approximately 01:50, I was traveling west on W. Tennessee St. and stopped at the red light at the intersection of Basin St. The light for westbound traffic on W. Tennessee St. turned green and I began to travel through the intersection. I observed a black SUV exit the Taco Bell located at 1506 W. Tennessee St. The black SUV began to travel south across the westbound lanes of W. Tennessee St. and it appeared the vehicle was attempting to make a left turn. The opposing lanes of W. Tennessee St. are separated by a raised concrete median which prevents vehicles from turning left from the north side of the street.

It appeared the driver realized the raised median was there just prior to striking it, and the vehicle turned right to travel west. The vehicle traveled to the intersection of Caliark St. and W. Tennessee St and entered the left turn lane. The traffic light was red for traffic traveling on W. Tennessee St. The vehicle stopped at the red light; however the entire vehicle was well past the stop bar.

When the light turned green, the black SUV made a U-turn and began traveling east on W. Tennessee St. As the vehicle traveled east in the outside lane, it almost struck the curb near the Papa John's Pizza, located at the intersection of Stadium and W. Tennessee St.

As the vehicle continued east, the vehicle began to travel approximately 45 mph in the 35 mph zone. The vehicle traveled through the intersection of Brevard and W. Tennessee St. Just east of the intersection with Brevard St., the black SUV veered to the right and struck the raised curb.

The black SUV continued east and approached the intersection of Dewey St. and W. Tennessee St. The traffic signal for traffic on W. Tennessee St. was red and had been for several seconds. The black SUV traveled through the intersection against the red light. The vehicle's brake lights did not come on.

I activated my emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on the black SUV (Florida tag HD77). The vehicle pulled into the parking lot of Target Copy, located at 635 W. Tennessee St. The SUV pulled into a marked parking spot and struck the concrete curb.

I approached the vehicle to make contact with the driver (defendant) and only occupant of the vehicle. The driver side window was down. Before I made contact with the driver, I could smell the strong odor of alcoholic beverage coming from the passenger compartment. I explained the reason for the stop and asked the defendant about running the red light. He originally stated he thought the light was yellow. When the defendant spoke, I could smell the strong odor of alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot, watery, and glassy. The defendant denied consuming any alcoholic beverages.

I returned to my vehicle and completed a citation for Failure to Obey a Traffic Control Device. After completing the citation, I called the defendant back to my vehicle to explain the citation. When the defendant

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exited, he stumbled to his left and fell against the rear passenger door of his vehicle.

As I explained the citation to the defendant, I continued to smell the odor of alcoholic beverage coming from the defendant. The defendant was swaying front to back while standing in the level parking lot.

I explained my concerns about possible impairment to the defendant. He again denied consuming any alcoholic beverages. When I asked him about the odor of alcohol coming from him and his vehicle, he advised he had friends in his vehicle earlier and they were at the bar.

I asked the defendant if he would be willing to perform Field Sobriety Exercises and he refused. I asked if there was a reason, and he stated he was "good to get home." I asked again and he again stated he did not want to do FSE's.

Based on my observations of impairment, the defendant was arrested for DUI. The defendant gave officers permission to properly park his vehicle and leave it on scene. When I opened the door to the defendant's vehicle, I no longer smelled the odor of alcoholic beverages inside the SUV. After the defendant's vehicle was properly parked, his keys, cell phone, and wallet were given to him.

The defendant was transported to LCJ without incident. At 02:34, I read the defendant Implied Consent. The defendant refused to provide a breath sample. I explained the consequences of a refusal to the defendant and he again refused to provide a breath sample. A Refusal Affidavit was completed. Post Miranda, [REDACTED]

The defendant was issued DUI citation 7334-XFD and UTC A00KQGE. The traffic stop was recorded on my vehicle's MAVRICS camera system.
